Of course, at Half Shell Oyster House, fresh shucked and charbroiled oysters are staples on the menu. However, the two-page dinner menu offers diners plenty to choose from. Hand-cut steaks, Chicken Alfredo, Seafood Stuffed Portabellas, Almond Encrusted Chicken, and a magical Voodoo Shrimp Poboy are a few of the menu selections. A unique facet of the restaurant are the Southern Pearl oysters, exclusively available at Half Shell Oyster House. The Southern Pearls are grown and harvested by Biloxi, Miss. based <u>Deer Island Oyster Company</u>. The oysters are grown at the mouth of the Mississippi Sound using off-bottom aquaculture, a method that provides a sustainable premium oyster. The Sound is plentiful with nutrients for oysters to grow, attributing to a distinct sweet, smooth, buttery, yet salty flavor. Southern Pearls will be available at the grand opening along with other select oysters from the Gulf.

Madison General Manager, Matt Geiken was asked what he looks forward to most about the Madison location, "Madison is a beautiful and very friendly town, I am grateful to be a part of it, and raise my family here. My family and I are very excited to move back to Mississippi to open this long-anticipated Half Shell Oyster House. I can't wait to welcome the community through our doors and to serve them amazing food and exceptional service."

The restaurant will open to the public at 11 a.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 30 and will be seating on a first come first serve basis. Masks are required upon entry. Curbside takeaway orders are available and can be placed by calling 601.790.1801. Groups no larger than ten may be seated together, and tables are situated at a minimum of six feet apart. The Half Shell Oyster House is located at 100 Merchant Street, Madison, MS 39110. Hours are Sunday – Thursday 11 a.m. – 10 p.m. and Friday & Saturday 11 a.m. – 11 p.m.. Lunch is available Monday – Friday 11 a.m. – 3 p.m. and brunch is every Sunday from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m.
